




Reception

Our School uses the typology of an older centre of learning, that lies at the heart of Armenian culture; the Monastery. Cloisters and courtyards link the various built elements of the School, providing constantly unfolding views and changing patterns of light to engage and inspire young minds.

Set atop a stone plinth, the carbon negative complex is entirely offsite fabricated and delivered as complete wall and roof bays, using an anti-prismatic Yoshimura folded plate comprising double-layered 40mm CLT panels with integral cellulose insulation at 350mm o/a thickness, as developed at the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology. The plan uses simple rectilinear shapes to enhance earthquake resistance, and a repetitive bay form that allows for interchangeable room functions and later expansion.


Rooms are careful to maximise daylight whilst limiting both solar gain and glare, with high level clerestories to gables and horizontal polished shelves to shade tall windows, reflecting sunlight up into the vaulted ceilings, negating the need for blinds. The CLT is expressed internally, lime-bleached in classrooms, and is clad in zinc shingles externally. The resultant skin is vapour open, requiring air handling in wet rooms

The School is located at the northeastern and flattest corner of the site, visible from the road, with the primary hall centred on the running track. The future Events Centre will face it across the sports field. As the School employs twin wood-chip biomass boilers, coupled to thermal stores, the flat southwestern grounds will grow mechanised fuel crops such as Acanthus. Using the topography of the site, rain water is stored in the upper half of the valley, with reed-bed sewage ponds in the lower reaches, orchards to the East taking up the nutrients. The steeper East-facing slopes are ideal for terraced vines.



First Floor Plan 1:200 0 ______10










